



WORKS MORATORIUM

Xmas - New Year 2009 - 2010

A works moratorium will be in place for all retail shopping areas within Auckland City as detailed below as well as for any local Xmas Parades should they fall outside these dates. Parade dates will be advised as they come to hand.

The moratorium applies to all works and operational activities in the road reserve, and is also applicable to all major arterial routes. If in doubt please contact the Transport Operations team at Auckland City, 379 2020.

Whilst the retailers acknowledge that your work cannot come to a halt, it will be appreciated by all if works are planned to avoid retail areas, facilitating ease of movement during what is traditionally the busiest time of the year.

Inclusive Moratorium Dates (CBD & Isthmus)

Saturday 5th December - Friday 11th December

Approval for any work during this period will be at the discretion of Transport Operations, Auckland City.

Saturday 12th December - Thursday 24th December

During this period, works of an emergency nature only, as defined in The Code of Practice for Working in the Road, shall be approved.

Inclusive Moratorium Dates (Waiheke)

Saturday 12th December - Monday 4th January

During this period, works of an emergency nature only, as defined in The Code of Practice for Working in the Road, shall be approved.

Farmers Santa Parade

The annual Farmers Santa Parade in Auckland's CBD is scheduled for Sunday 29th November (rain date Sunday 6th December).

This event draws in excess of 200,000 people and the impact zone extends across that part of the CBD bordered by Nelson Street, Quay Street, Symonds Street & Karangahape Road.

No works shall be permitted within the impact zone on the day of the parade and any works in progress are to be made safe, with all equipment not needed for safety reasons removed from the site.
