I oppose the proposal because our residential street is already used by traffic to cut through from Dominion Rd to Sandringham Rd. Our street is narrow and straight and the first one linking the two main roads before Balmoral Rd. Cars travel at high speed down the street making it dangerous for children. With a larger St Lukes, more traffic will want to avoid the lights on the main road and 'cut through' Parrish / St Albans Rds. A lot of young children live on our street and the increased volumes of traffic will make the street a lot more dangerous.

Similarly a lot of traffic 'cuts through' Wibblehurst Park where a large number of children play daily. A larger St Lukes will increase this traffic again increasing the danger for the children of the neighbourhood.
