HISTORY & KNOWN ASSOCIATIONS This building was built for the Seventh Day Adventist church in 1964 and cost £30,000. It was officially opened on 11 March 1964 by the Minister of Housing Mr McRae. Pastor D Sibley, president of the Trans Tasman Union Conference of Seventh Day Adventists from Sydney was present for the opening. The two level building incorporated the Church's offices, and Auckland's e six dial-a-prayer machines. A large hall behind this building had previously been used by the Seventh Day Adventist Church meetings. It is now used by the school. Previously the Church's headquarters had been located in Esplanade Road in Mt Eden. That site was to be redeveloped to provide accommodation for the elderly. The Seventh Day Adventist Church at the north end of Dominion Road, facing onto Brentwood Ave was opened in July 1960.	ZONING Business 2
