

Auckland Council District Plan - Auckland City Isthmus Section 1999

Further Submissions: Newmarket Growth Area Structure Plan

In accordance with the enforcement direction from the Environment Court dated 19 December 2011 and clause 7 of the 1st Schedule of the Resource Management Act, part of the submission made by New Zealand Historic Places Trust on Proposed Plan Change 196 to the Auckland Council (Auckland City Isthmus Section 1999) District Plan is to be renotified.

The submission point that is being renotified relates to whether the building at 61-73 Davis Crescent, legally described as Pt Lot 1 and Lot 2 DP 23481, located on the south western corner of the Davis Crescent and Short Street intersection should be indentified as a character building. This renotification addresses uncertainty around the exact location of the building in question.

Following receipt of any further submissions received in accordance with the requirements of the Act, Auckland Council will continue to process this issue as set out in the 1st Schedule of the Act.
