Further Submission to Plan Modifications 372 and 373

- The Society's further submission relates to original submission numbers: 157 Ngati Te Ata Waiohua 163 Te Kawerau lwi Tribal Authority 236 Ngati Tamaoho
- The Society acknowledges that all three submissions offer only partial support for these proposals and that no iwi has yet taken a final position. In many ways this is similar to the Society. We have stated that with quarrying finished, the site will have to be put to another use.
- The Society is supportive of a strong Maori element to the landscaping and visual interpretation of the site. We offer as proof of this the final design at Puketapapa which was achieved after consultation with iwi.
- 4. Our concern with the iwi submissions is whether enough consideration has been given to the spatial aspects of the landscape treatment as opposed to the more detailed design that should come after. There is a cart before the horse element.
- All iwi submissions tend to favour Plan Change 372. The Society favours Plan Change 373. We are very concerned about the loss of Western Park. As stated in our submission, this does have considerable landscape value for the maunga.

- 6. A considerable number of people can be housed in the area using either plan change, but the desired level of population in this development should be driven by the land itself. The Society submits that Three Kings is an historic, culturally important, sensitive volcanic landscape and this should be the principal factor guiding the design. This may result in a lower number of people living there than the applicant wishes.
- 7. Like iwi, the Society has supported a playing field in the quarry. However, like other submitters, we have recommended that it be put at the northern end of the site. This would "fit into" the mountain better, especially if proper remedial work was undertaken on the precipitous cut quarry face on the eastern side of the maunga.
- 8. The Society noted the offer by Fletchers at the recent Maunga Authority meeting, of this cut quarry face to iwi for inclusion in the maunga reserve. This quarry face is controversial. It is not an original landscape feature and it is questionable as to what value it brings to the site. Having to plant it out, irrespective of what species of plant are used, is indicative of a problem. We would ask the iwi to give very careful consideration to this matter.
- The Society would contend that a gentler restored slope on this part of Te Tatua a Riukiuta would be a better outcome than a large ladder arrangement for accessing the maunga from Mt Eden Road.
- 10. The Society is concerned that iwi have offered only their partial support to the plan changes. With this in mind, the Society does not consider it is the green light that the applicant thinks it is. To our mind, it is not just a matter of a few minor adjustments to gain full acceptance. No iwi has accepted any design as a final version.
- 11. The Society still considers that, until there is a better overall landscape understanding, both plan changes should be declined.
