ORDER GRANTING CONSENT

HAVING CONSIDERED the application, the memorandum filed on behalf of the applicant, and the affidavit of Trevor Stewart Mackie submitted in support of the application, AND UPON HEARING counsel for the applicant AND THERE BEING no notice lodged by any person or body served with the application and seeking to be heard THIS COURT HEREBY ORDERS that consent be given under clause 17(2) of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991 to the North Shore City Council approving part of its proposed district plan, namely, the designation and associated plan provisions for part of the Auckland prison at Paremoremo and the objectives, policies and rules relating to the general tree protection controls across the City.

This order does not affect those parts of the plan which are affected by unresolved references, variations and designations as listed in exhibit C to the affidavit of Trevor Stewart Mackie, more particularly being the sites identified on the maps and the provisions of the proposed plan described in the Schedule that comprises that exhibit.
