**Subject: Errata to AEE North Harbour Watermain and Northern Interceptor in Shared Corridor**

Dear Tim

Further to our discussions Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May, we have sought clarification with respect to the paragraph in the Assessment of Effects on the Environment report lodged for the North Harbour Watermain and Northern Interceptor in the shared corridor project relating to potential settlement. This letter serves as an errata notice to amend the third paragraph on page 84 to read:

*Trenched sections will be largely confined to the road reserve and features either side of the trench are likely to settle. Without mitigation, potential adverse settlement effects greater than 10mm may extend into residential properties at some locations depending on ground conditions. At very limited locations, these would extend into buildings or house footprints within these properties; in all cases settlement is considered "slight" (lower than 20mm) (note that less than 10mm is considered within the range of settlement that would result from seasonal weather conditions).*

We would appreciate a copy of this errata being enclosed or appended to all Auckland Council copies of the AEE that have been provided.
