RULE 1

MAINTENANCE AND CONDITION OF LAND AND BUILDINGS

RULES

1.0 General

The following rules shall apply where relevant to Any Activity in all Human Environments except the Working Environment.

Non-Complying Activities

- (a) Any building which, due to inadequate maintenance, has an external appearance detracting from amenity values neighbourhood character.
- (b) Land which, due to inadequate maintenance or the presence of structures or vehicles or other materials or storage of materials or property detracts from amenity values or neighbourhood character.

NOTES

- 1. If an activity is not controlled or restricted in any way by any part of the Plan it is permitted, but it may require consents under other legislation/plans. See also Section 17 of the Act which applies irrespective of the rules in the *Plan* (and which may apply, for instance, in respect of activities relating to the maintenance of land and buildings in the Working Environment).
- Activities must comply with all other relevant rules of the Plan or be the subject of a resource consent. Check all Human Environment Rules, Natural Areas Rules and City-Wide Rules
- Words in italics are defined see the Definitions part of the City-Wide Rules.
- Words in Bold are explained see the Explanations part of the Introduction to the Rules.
- The Council may have a guideline to help interpret this rule - check at the Council Offices.
