RULE 1

TEMPORARY ACTIVITIES

RULES

See also Policies 1.19, 10.14 (Policy Section of the Waitakere District Plan)

1.0 General

The following rules shall apply to *Temporary Activities*.

1.1 Permitted Activities

Activities meeting the following Performance Standard are *Permitted Activities*:

- *Temporary Activities* which are a *Permitted Activity* or have received a *resource consent* in respect of any relevant rules of the *Plan* relating to:
 - the General Noise Standards within the *City-Wide Rules*
 - the *Heritage Rules*
 - the *Natural Area* within which the *site* is located; and
 - the odour, glare, *dust*, vibration and air discharges, *hazardous facilities* and *signs* rules applying to the *Human Environment* within which the *site* is located.

Note: The above rules shall not compromise the ability of the *Council* or any other person to pursue action relating to adverse *effects* on the *environment*. (See sections 16 and 17 of the *Act*).

1.2 Non-Complying Activities

Any Activity to which this rule applies which is not a *Permitted Activity* under the above rule shall be deemed to contravene a rule in this *Plan* and shall be a *Non-Complying Activity*.

NOTES

1. If an activity is not controlled or restricted in any way by any part of the *Plan* it is permitted, but may require consents under other legislation/ plans.
2. Words in *italics* are defined - see the Definitions part of the *City-Wide Rules*.
3. The Council may have a guideline to help interpret this rule - check at the Council Offices.

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
