

Area Profiles: Newmarket

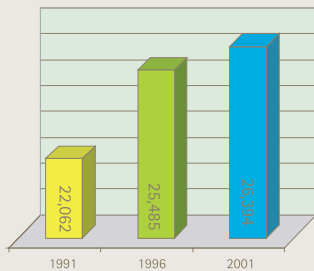


The 10 census area units (CAU) of Newmarket cover a wider community than just the 800m radius around the town centre (the "area of change").

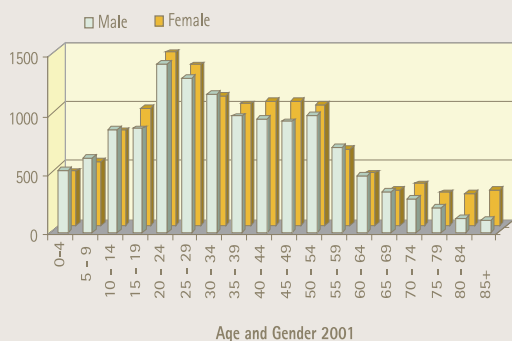
Relative to Auckland City Newmarket has :

- High median household income
- More European residents and less Maori and Pacific Island residents
- 7% with no qualification, compared with 15% in Auckland City.
- 49% of people gainfully employed as full time, compared with 47% in Auckland City.
- The average household size was 2.4 people, compared with 2.7 for Auckland City.
- There were 9720 households in Newmarket, of which 2238 were in the household composition category of "couple with children" and 2538 were "one person household".
- The unemployment rate was 4%, compared with Auckland City percent of 5.

Population and growth since 1991

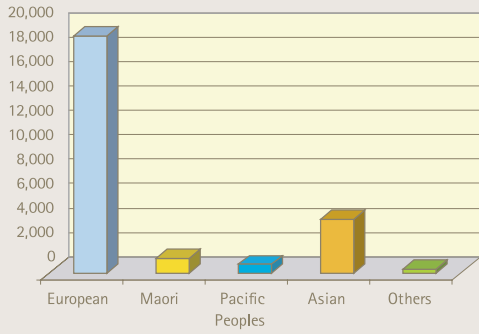

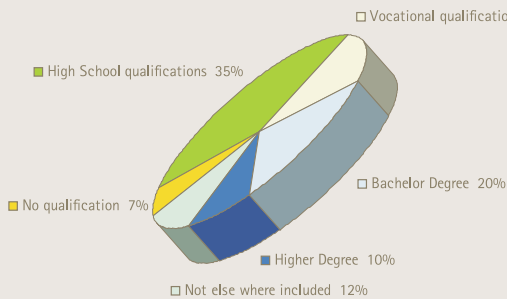

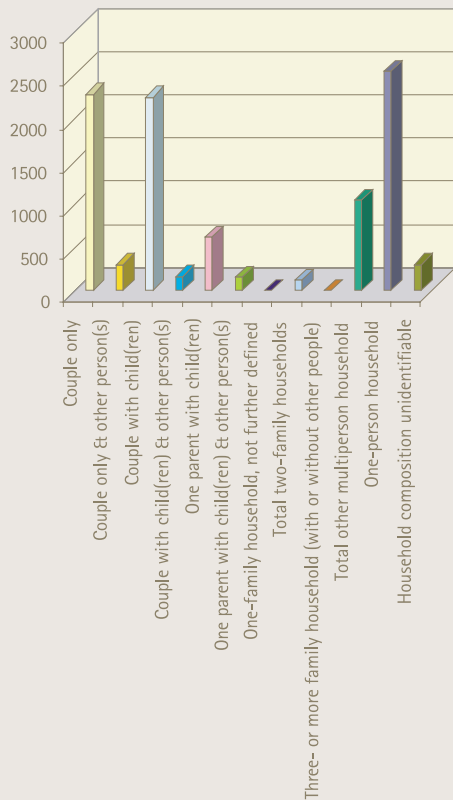

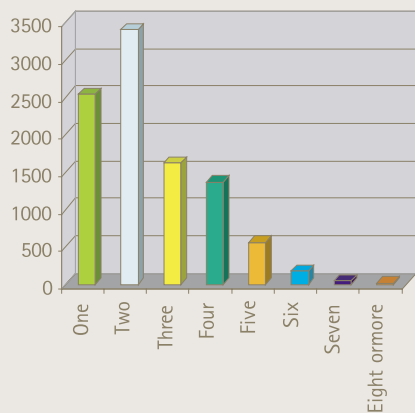

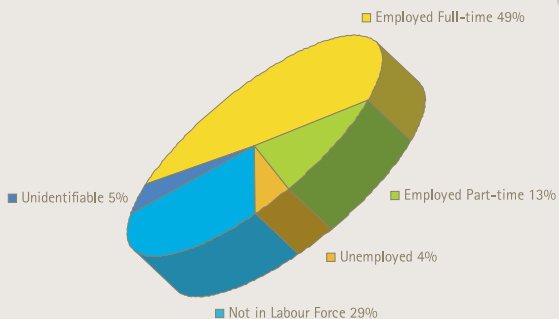
