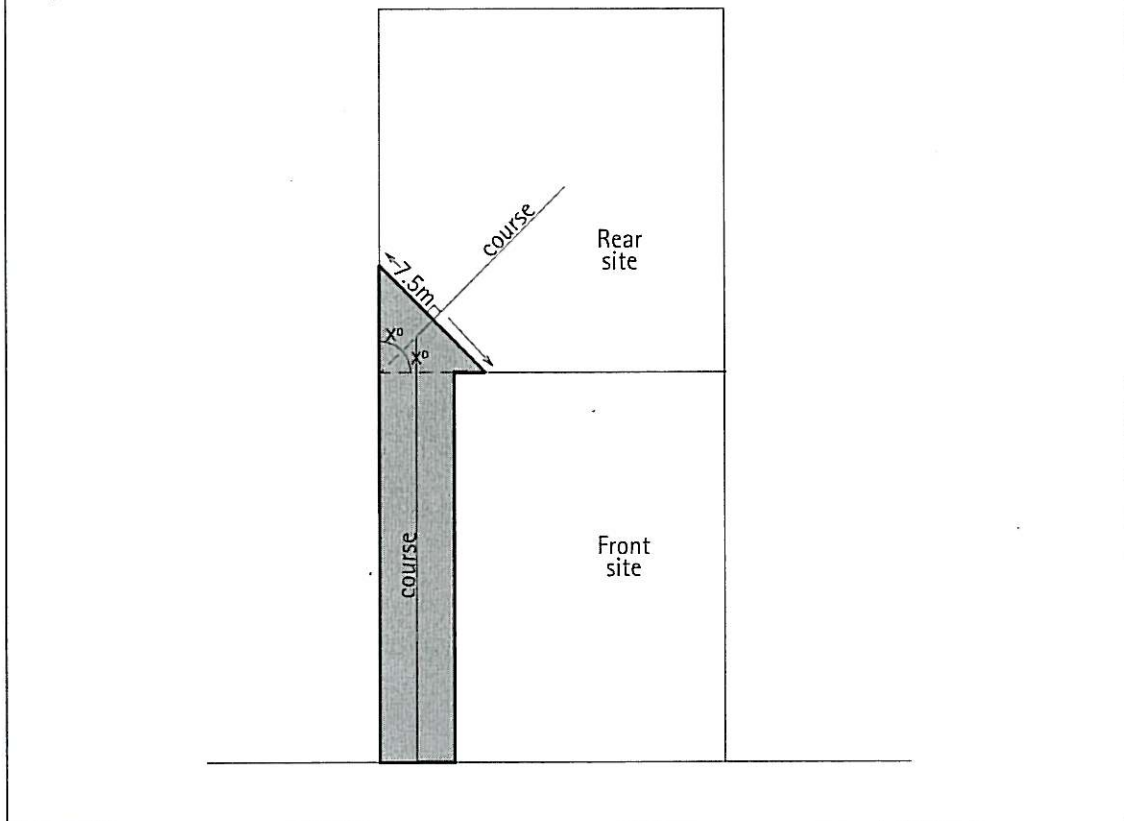


Figure 14.1 Entrance strip



Environment	has the same meaning as in the RMA.
Erosion risk zone	means land and sites likely to be affected by coastal erosion. Land and sites within an 'erosion risk zone' is identified on the planning maps.
Exploration	means: 'any activity undertaken for the purpose of identifying mineral deposits or occurrences and evaluating the feasibility of mining particular deposits or occurrences of one or more minerals; and includes any drilling, dredging, or excavations (whether surface or sub-surface) that are reasonably necessary to determine the nature and size of a mineral deposit or occurrence; and 'to explore' has a corresponding meaning' This is the same definition as in the Crown Minerals Act 1991.
Freight handling and wharf administration activities	means land or buildings used for any of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • administrative offices associated with a wharf • the moving or storage of freight.
Forestry	means the management of land for commercial wood production including the extraction of timber. It does not include any of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the milling or processing of timber • commercial firewood harvesting.
