NOTICE OF PERSON'S WISH TO BE PARTY TO PROCEEDINGS

To the Registrar,

In re: Lodgement ENV – 2009- AKL – 000329

1. I, Ronald Alfred Walden, wishes to be a party to the following proceedings under s 274 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (the Act) in relation to an appeal under clause 14(1) of the Act by Auckland Regional Council regarding decisions made by the Auckland City Council (the Council) on the Auckland City District Plan – Hauraki Gulf Islands – Proposed Plan 2006 (HGI Plan):

I claim status to be heard as a party who made submissions.

I own land in Rural 1 and 2 affected by this decision.

2. I am interested in parts of the proceedings.
 - a. The proceedings I am interested in are: The appeal relating to the current state of formal identification including location and evaluation of cultural heritage resources on the Hauraki Gulf Islands.
 - b. The assessment of ecological values in Rural 1 and 2

I am interested the protection, maintenance and where possible enhancement of those cultural heritage sites.

I am interested in the identification and protection of the ecological values of the rural 1 and 2 land units.

3. I support the relief sought because—
 - a. Will promote the sustainable management of resources;
 - b. Is not contrary to part II of the Resource Management Act 1991(the Act);
 - c. Will meet the reasonably foreseeable needs of future generations;
 - d. Will enable social, economic and cultural wellbeing.
 - e. Will provide for the cultural and recreational wellbeing of the communities of the gulf.
 - f. Is not contrary to the purposes and provisions of the Act;
 - g. Is not in-appropriate and is [not] inconsistent with the purposes and principles of the Act;
 - h. Is necessary to avoid, remedy or mitigate the adverse effects of the proposed plan provisions;

- i. Will promote the life supporting capacity of the environment of the gulf for the social, economic, recreational, and cultural well-being of people and communities of the gulf.
 - j. Will promote the life supporting capacity of the environment of the gulf enabling the resources of the Gulf to be used by the people and communities of the Gulf and New Zealand for economic activities and recreation.
 - k. Will provide for the protection of the cultural and historic associations of people and communities in and around the Hauraki Gulf with its natural, historic, and physical resources
 - l. Will provide for the maintenance and, where appropriate, the enhancement of the contribution of the natural, historic, and physical resources of the Hauraki Gulf, its islands, and catchments to the social and economic well-being of the people and communities of the Hauraki Gulf and New Zealand
 - m. Will provide for the protection of the cultural and historic associations of people and communities in and around the Hauraki Gulf with its natural, historic, and physical resources:
 - n. Will provide for the maintenance and, where appropriate, the enhancement of the natural, historic, and physical resources of the Hauraki Gulf, its islands, and catchments, which contribute to the recreation and enjoyment of the Hauraki Gulf for the people and communities of the Hauraki Gulf and New Zealand
4. Further reasons for the relief sought;
- a. I support the relief sought for the protection of cultural heritage and ecological values. Cultural heritage of all New Zealand is a precious gift of previous generations, a resource, and gives us as a nation an identity. This heritage is prescribed in the Hauraki Gulf Marine Park Act 2000 and the Resource Management Act 1991. Not to protect that heritage is not to fulfil the obligations under s 5 of the Resource Management Act and the Hauraki Gulf Marine Park Act 2000.
 - b. I support the identification and protection of ecological values and ecosystem values in Rural 1 and 2. Ecological values and their preservation reflect man's symbiotic relation to the environment and our duty to preserve and care for that environment. Failure to identify and protect those values is a direct failure to implement the statutory instruments that regulate the impact of man on the environment.
5. I agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
