1. Man O'War Farm Limited ("**MOWF**") wishes to be a party to the following proceedings:
  - *New Zealand Historic Places Trust v Auckland City Council* (ENV-2009-AKL-000351) being a reference appeal filed pursuant to Clause 14 of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991 regarding the Proposed Hauraki Gulf Islands District Plan ("**Proposed Plan**").
2. MOWF lodged submissions on the provisions of the Proposed Plan subject of the proceedings, and/ or is a person having an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the public generally, in light of the heritage schedulings applied to its properties, and as raised by the proceedings.
