The Particular Parts of the submission we support are:

That Part 4.5 of the PP "Temporary Activities" allows for entertainment of a very intrusive nature and opens the door to intensive interruption in a neighbourhood or community.

Policing of the standards set in 4.5 will be impossible, and proof of duration and time of activities will be up to affected neighbours.

The Reasons for our support to the above submission are:

We submit that Temporary Activities events usually have associated adverse effects which are more than minor.

We submit that such adverse effects result from the consequent noise pollution of partying congregations of people, and loud music, and loud cars and helicopter noise.

Such noise seriously challenges the well-being of Waiheke residential community

Experience has shown that policing of noise levels is onerous upon the affected, and most unsatisfactory in implementation.

We seek... That the whole submission be allowed -
