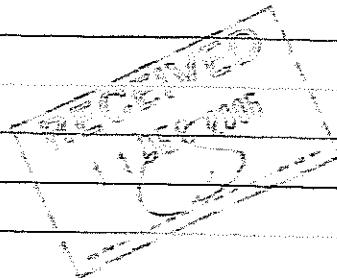

The "informed road" crossing along the coastal cliff and the beach at Ahiwa should be a totally anomalous. The upper part labelled "Ostea road" is steep and follows a ridge which is highly prominent from the camp ground and estuary. It reaches the seaward river at the Waiata Road Flocking site.

This road designation is burdensome. It would not be possible to make a road along most of it (beach and cliffs). A better road, if ever constructed, would divert traffic to an area of ecological significance (CO-7).

Currently, because the estuary is designated "road", local beach-care groups (and Nat.) are permitted to stop anyone driving down Queen road and along the beach. This area is one of the 4 nesting sites for NZ Petrels (landings) on Great Barrier.
