The Particular Parts of the submission I / we support are:

That the planning maps be scrapped and all ridgelines be double-checked throughout and new planning maps be produced that reflect true contours.

The Reasons for my / our support to the above submission are:

Ridgelines are very significant both ecologically and in terms of visual landscape. The planning maps should therefore be ground-truthed and all ridges, but especially skylines when viewed from both off the island and public places, protected from built structures. Wording such as the following would provide certainty:

*Significant ridgeline area* means an area adjacent to any significant ridgeline as identified on the planning maps. For the purpose of the development control rules, the significant ridgeline area includes all land falling within the 100m-wide strip shown on the planning maps by way of a dotted line notation parallel to each defined ridgeline.
