Further Submission to the Proposed Hauraki Gulf Islands District Plan

Re Submission # 3521/160 from the Auckland Regional Council

We oppose the above submission to delete the proposed re-zoning of the street frontage along the western end of Tiri Rd simply because the strip of land concerned is currently outside the MUL of the ARC's AK Regional Policy Statement. The proposed re-zoning has merit and should not be dropped simply because a document in another council has not yet caught up with the proposal. Rather, the ACC should instead work with the ARC to satisfy the ARC that the relevant provisions of the AK Regional Policy Statement can be met and so arrange for the MUL to be extended to include this strip of land.
