Re: Part 13.8.5 - That Council's assessment of the overall impact of helicopters also includes consideration of the cumulative effects of the number of helipads sites in Rural 1 - 2.

The Reasons for my / our support to the above submission are:

- That community well-being and related amenity values of quiet are very important.
- That the adverse effects of helicopter operations are more than minor.
- That cumulative effects of multiple helipads add up to an intolerable nuisance.
