The reasons for my/~~our~~ support/ opposition are:

To exclude from 10a.18.6.10 public carparking areas existing as at Sept 2006 would be acceptable only if this is completely consistent with the Stage Two Design Brief. In para 6.0 of the stage two brief it states that it may be necessary to stage construction and “ ‘landbank’ part of the development as carparking.”..... [and] it is likely that the critical first stage of the development will be resolving the carparking and transport issues.” The Matiatia gateway development should be staged and the public parking spaces existing at present should remain for 3-5 years until an overall comprehensive Waiheke Transport Strategy is finalised. Amongst other things this strategy would determine what the long term public parking needs are for Matiatia and all other parts of Waiheke.
