

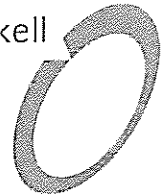

3. The reason for the further submission is:

3.1 The submission raises a number of points. The reasons for, and the support or opposition to the submission points are set out below:

2523/1	10a.27.3	Support in part	While the Army support landscaping and managed native revegetation planting of the Island, the Army submit that that an overall target of 50% native revegetation of the Island is unreasonable and overly restrictive.
2523/2	10a.27.7.2	Support in part	While the Army support landscaping and managed native revegetation planting of the Island, the Army submit that that an overall target of 50% native revegetation of the Island is unreasonable and overly restrictive.
2523/3	10a.27.7.2	Support in part	The Army consider that a ban on mustelids and cats is an appropriate conservation measure, but do not consider that given the unique manner in which the island is to be utilised that a total ban on domestic dogs is appropriate.
2523/5	10a.27.5.1	Support	The Army support the submission to delete provision for playgrounds and Visitor Information Centre from the Conservation/Residential Area. Because the Conservation/Residential Area is not intended to be the first point of arrival, it is ineffective planning to locate the Visitor Information Centre in the Conservation/Residential Area.

3.2 The Army wishes to be heard in respect of this further submission. If others make similar further submissions, the Submitter will be prepared to consider presenting a joint case with them at any hearing.
