The reasons for my / our support or opposition to the above submission are:

The submission fails to recognise that the purpose of the RMA 1991 (the Act) involves managing use and development "in a way, or at a rate which enables people and communities to provide for their social, economic and cultural wellbeing...". The submission effectively implies that once the (unspecified and unsupported) thresholds are met no use and development would be allowed thereby negating the overriding management purpose and enabling intention of the Act. Furthermore the submission fails to recognise that the social, economic and cultural wellbeing of people is not fixed to permanent thresholds but evolves as the community's social, economic and cultural values and needs change over time. Giving effect to the submission amounts to the imposition of the values of a certain sector of today's community on future generations.
