allowing more helicopter landings with less restrictions

The reasons for my / our support or opposition to the above submission are:
On islands other than Waiheke (e.g. rakino 10 acre blocks -proposed new LU3?) there are many large blocks of land that are either on peninsulars or totally coastal that can be accessed by helicopter directly from the sea without having to fly over other unrelated private land and can take off and land quickly and quietly without being obtrusive. The 'one size fits all' approach is thus incorrect and the proposed new plan needs to make allowance for the above situations, where proposed restrictions in the plan are clearly excessive. We see no reason for any limit in such a situation and certainly not @ the proposed level. If a limit is to be made it should, for such landblocks in the above situation, allow for two per day on condition the helicopter comes in over the sea and does not fly in over other private property to land/take off.
