


**Figure 10:**

Pest plants noted were the Surveillance (ARC RPMS 2002-07) species alligator weed (*Alternanthera philoxeroides*), parrot's feather (*Myriophyllum aquaticum*), yellow flag (*Iris pseudacorus*), reed sweet grass (*Glyceria maxima*), lagarosiphon (*Lagarosiphon major*) and egeria (*Egeria densa*). Additional problem weeds seen which are not included in the ARC RPMS were water celery (*Apium nodiflorum*) and Mercer grass (*Paspalum distichum*).
